The **COLE HARBOUR COMMUNITY FRIDGE,** located in the small building behind Cole Harbour Woodside United Church, is very busy and needs fresh supplies regularly for both the refrigerator and the food shelves. If anyone is so inclined, please visit the Fridge and drop off some groceries. The building is open 24 hours a day.

COLE HARBOUR CARES: A meeting was held on January 30 which Karen Watts and I were unable to attend; but the minutes of the meeting were provided. The two Syrian refugee families we helped to settle are thriving, and all have become Canadian citizens. The family of three, mother (Sarah), father and child in Lebanon, for whom we were asked to raise money, were not successful in their application interview with the Canadian Embassy in Beirut. As a result, their application was denied, and they chose not to appeal the decision. The two young men included in the request to raise funds did not provide necessary information or applications. The current balance of the funds raised is \$35,315.37. A motion was passed to disband Cole Harbour Cares after the CHWUC AGM in March. Among the reasons for doing so were the age of members, the required time commitment and the availability of volunteers. Another motion passed to stipulate dispersal of the funds equally to two organizations that have settled refugees in Nova Scotia - Open Harbour Refugee Association and Hants East Assisting Refugees Team in Elmsdale. Dispersal would also occur after the AGM at Cole Harbour Woodside United Church in March. Brenda Tucker.
