## GENERAL INFORMATION

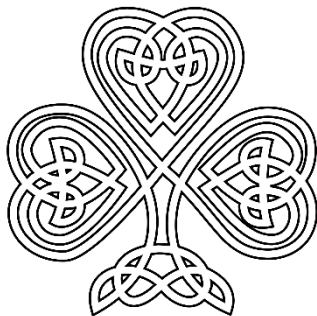
