All parishioners are invited to attend a Special Meeting of the Parish on **Sunday, June 9, 2024 at 12:30 p.m.**

On May 20, 2024 Parish Council approved a recommendation from the Sustainable Income Task Force to convene a Special Parish Meeting to review and discuss a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Cole Harbour Minor Basketball Association and the Church of Saint Andrew.

The purpose of the MOU is to establish the relationship between the Association and the Parish relative to the lease of our property beyond the parking lot. The meeting will include a brief presentation by the Task Force and a presentation by Robin Veinotte, President, Cole Harbor Rocket Basketball. There will be an opportunity for questions prior to the motion being read and a vote by the parish.
