November 4, 5 & 6: Our Parish will be the location of a three-day Clergy gathering hosted by Bishop Sandra.

What does that mean for us? These sessions will be in the church itself, so activities down the hall, including meetings, continue as scheduled. Please remember to enter the building through the door by the Library, not the church door, on these days.
